



Lakes & Streams Art Contest

Overview: Calling all 4th-12th graders for the Lilly Center for Lakes & Streams Lakes Art Contest! Help us raise awareness of and appreciation for Kosciusko County's waters through artistic expression. This year's contest theme is **Life at the Lake**. Entries should include a lake or stream and show students' understanding of the theme. Deadline is **Wednesday April 15, 2020**.

Prizes: Artwork is judged by the Grace College Art Department and evaluated based on creativity, artistic merit and depiction of the theme. Prizes will be awarded for First (\$65), Second (\$45) and Third (\$35) places with honorable mentions (\$10). Winners will be selected in each of the following grade categories: 4th/5th, 6th/7th, 8th/9th, 10th, 11th and 12th.

Restrictions: One entry per student. Students may use any medium, but the artwork must be one-dimensional and should not be folded, mounted, matted or framed. Do not use sand, glitter or material that may flake. A fixative must be sprayed on work using pastel or charcoal. Artwork should be neither smaller than 8"x10" nor larger than 16"x20". **No artwork depicting invasive species (i.e. trumpeter and tundra swans are acceptable, mute swans are not) will be considered.**

Entry forms must be attached to the upper right corner on the back of the entry.

Artwork is returned to students after the judging process, unless the artwork is a winning selection. Winning selections will be returned following display around the community.
